

Locating Permanent Links of EBSCO articles

1. Go to the KCU library home page (<http://www.kcu.edu/library>)
2. Click on "Research" in the column on the left
3. Click on Databases
4. Select your database (Example: "CINAHL")
5. Type in your search term or terms. For example, the title of an article.

6. Click on the "PDF" of the article.
