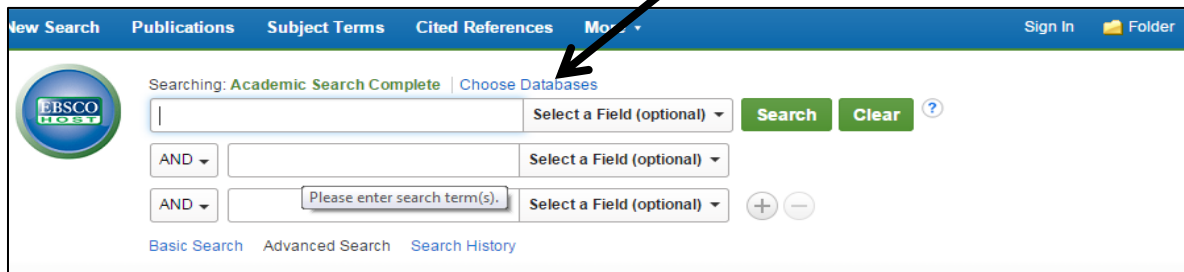
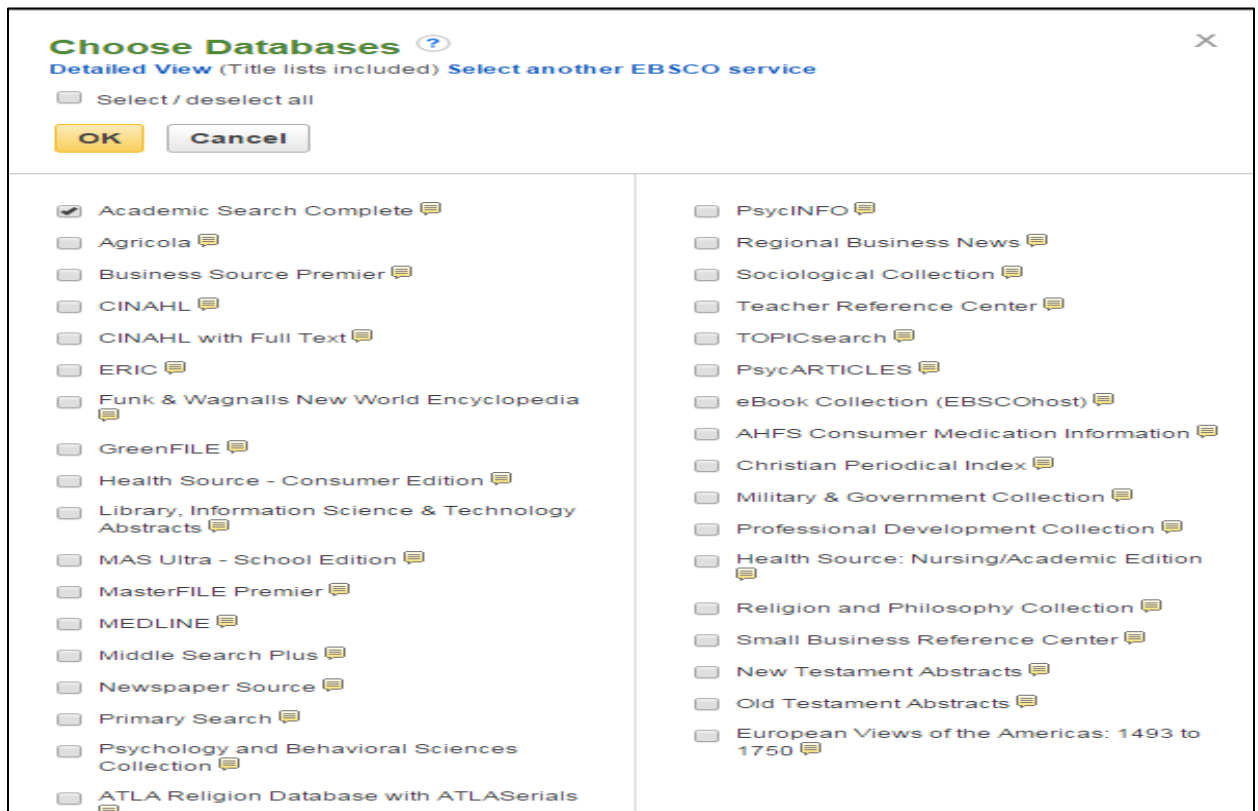


# How to search multiple EBSCO databases at the same time


1. Go to the Library home page (<http://www.kcu.edu/library>)
2. Click on the work “Research” in the column on the left
3. Click on “Databases”
4. Click on “Academic Search Complete” under the heading **General Studies**.
5. Once the database opens click on “Choose Databases” next to the title of the database.



6. Put check marks by the EBSCO databases that you want to search and click “OK”.



7. Next type in your search terms as you would normally
8. The number of articles from each database will be listed at the bottom of the column on the left on your Results page
