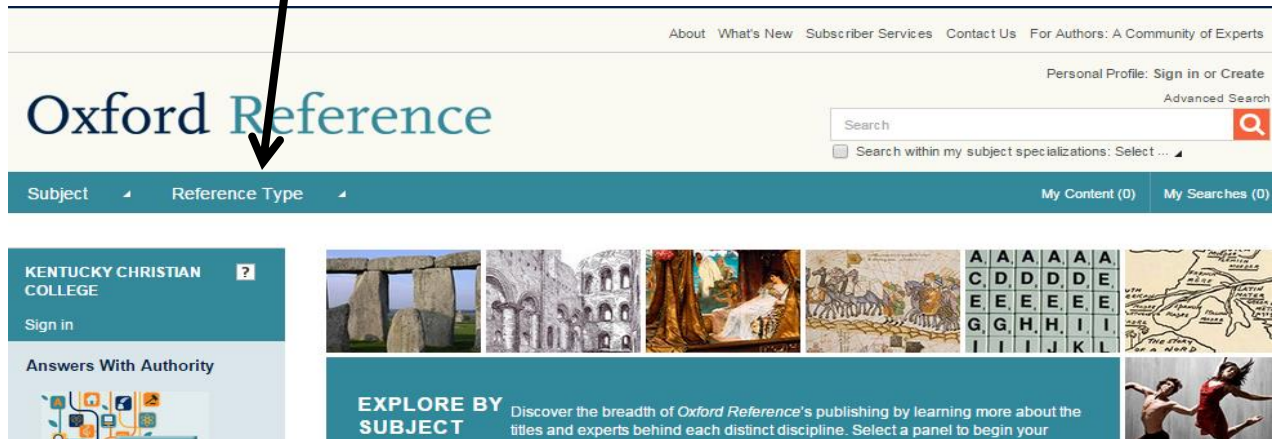
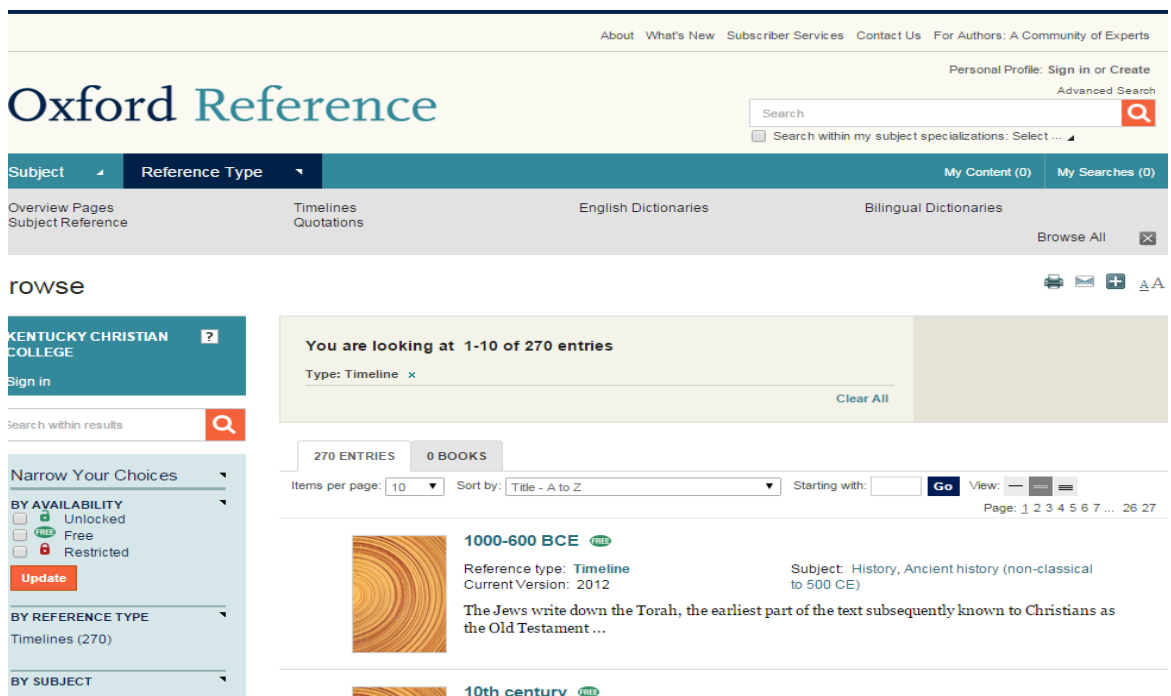


How to Use Oxford Reference Timeline Feature

1. Go to the library home page (<http://www.kcu.edu/library>)
2. Click on “Research” in the column on the left
3. Click on “Databases”
4. Click on “Oxford Reference” under **General Studies** on the database list
5. Click on “Reference Type” on the bar below the database title



6. Click on “Timelines”
7. Select a timeline from the results list



8. You should see a list of events in chronological order

9. Events can be expanded and additional articles can be referenced by clicking on the green triangle at the end of the “event”
