Kentucky Christian University Diversity Scholarship Application

A diverse applicant, eligible for assistance from the Diversity Scholarship Program, is a person who by reason of past racial or ethnic discrimination, or by reason of educational or economic deprivation, is unable to pay the costs of an education at Kentucky Christian University without financial assistance.

Up to ten (10) Diversity Scholarships are awarded on an annual basis. Awards are for up to \$3,000 per year (\$1,500 per semester) for Kentucky residents and \$5,000 per year (\$2,500 per semester) for out-of-state students. All students receiving diversity awards must be continuously enrolled (i.e., each fall and spring semester) in a minimum of 15 credit hours per semester and must maintain a minimum 2.5 cumulative grade point average in all KCU course work.*

*Students receiving athletic scholarship are ineligible for the Diversity Scholarship.

Procedure

- 1) Students applying for the Diversity Scholarship must first apply and be admitted to the University
- 2) Upon acceptance, students from diverse backgrounds may contact the Director of Admissions (606-474-3266) to discuss the Diversity Scholarship Program
- 3) Students must them complete this Diversity Scholarship Program Application.
- 4) The Director of Admissions and the Enrollment Management Committee will review all Diversity Scholarship Applications during regularly scheduled committee meetings.
- 5) Formal acknowledgement of Diversity Scholarship Program awards will be communicated to applicants by Admissions staff.
