- Chapel Services Twice per week chapel services provide students with meaningful and thought provoking messages while providing the best in worship by our on-campus worship teams. Chapel is required at KCU, and is often one of the fondest memories of our alumni!
- Life Groups Several faculty and staff members at KCU sponsor special "Life Groups" which meet on a regular basis for social activities, Bible study, and food! This is a great opportunity to get to know your professors and other students.
- **Dorm Devotions** In many instances, students will experience regular devotional times in their dorms, led by their resident assistants (RA's).
- **Spring Fling** This is a special day during the spring semester when students get a "surprise" day off with lots of fun activities, food, and a service project in the community. This gives KCU



the opportunity to go out into the community and provides students the opportunity to serve and share Christ with others.

- Mission Trips During the school year, there are several opportunities for students to participate in mission trips (many of which take place during spring break). Trips in the recent past have included mission work in the Dominican Republic, Haiti, and Ireland.






















## A great part of college life is doing things together as a campus family!
