# Be A Leader Who Is...

## **Authentic**

Always be real, always be you. "People would rather follow a leader who is always real, than one who is always right" (Craig Groeschel). The students that are involved in your group want to see the real you. Don't be afraid to be transparent and vulnerable with your students. When you create an atmosphere of authenticity, we begin to see the students connect and open themselves up in a way that is life changing, not just for them but to yourself as well.

# <u>Progressing</u>

Progression, not perfection. Seek to make the daily efforts to develop. There may be times within your life group that you feel you have hit a brick wall. During those times focus on progressing and taking the small steps with your students. Do not always have the thought of perfection on your mind, but instead shift your focus from perfection to excellence. When we seek excellence, we see ourselves progressing.

## <u>Dynamic</u>

Being comfortable in the uncomfortable. Allow yourself to think outside the box for lesson plans and activities. Embracing the charisma, and creativity during the process. Create an environment for imagination to be running wild for your group.



## <u>Visional</u>

We must understand our *why* because everything we do flows from it. If we do not understand why we are doing what we are doing, then the reason we are doing it simply is not enough.

# Do NOT be a leader who is

## <u>Domineering</u>

A domineering leader leads from a place of control, not encouragement.
Others who are around a domineering leader may begin to feel overwhelmed, pressured, verbaly and mentally exhausted.

## <u>Aggressive</u>

An aggressive leader continues to lead but in a way that forces other do what they are told. Alot like the domineering leader, the aggressive leader seeks to tell people what to do, rather than guide them.

# **Example Devotion**

## How to give a good devotional

#### • Start with scripture

- This will determine where you will go with your story. PLEASE make sure that you know the context of the scripture. Who, what, when, where, and why! Know this before you teach others. It's so easy to make scripture say what you want it to say.
- Pick Scriptures that speak to you personally.

#### • Personal story

- This can be something small, something that happened to you in the past, or a story of a friend.
- Make sure it's interesting and has a point that aligns with your scripture.
  - Adjust your story to the scripture
  - Do not adjust scripture to your story
- How God worked through your story
  - What is something that God revealed to you through this story. Try not to stretch scripture or what you want to teach to fit the story.

## • Where you are now

- What has God has taught you since then?
- Is what happened changed the course of how you think or live out your Christian walk.

## • How this applies to their life

- How can your audience learn through your story? Keep it light and short.
   Then always open up discussion!
- o This is where a connection may happen with someone new.
