May 4th - September 11th!

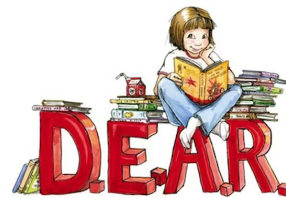

As in the past, this year's challenge includes reading both fiction and non-fiction titles. Each title read qualifies you to place your name in a drawing for a \$25 gift certificate to Amazon. A total of 5 certificates will be awarded. Participation is not mandatory, but this is a great opportunity to relax, as well as to maintain your current reading speed. Reading for class assignments can be difficult and time consuming at the beginning of the semester, especially after a long summer break. Staying "in practice" will help you to complete reading assignments more quickly and more efficiently in the fall.
