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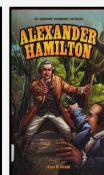
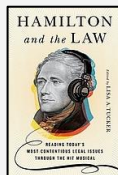
Constitution Day



Constitution Day is celebrated each year on September 17th to recognize the signing of the United States Constitution in 1787. The Constitution established the foundation of our government and remains an important part of American history and life today. One fun way to connect with this history is through the musical *Hamilton*, created by Lin-Manuel Miranda. The musical tells the story of Alexander Hamilton and other Founding Fathers during the early years of our nation. Hamilton was a delegate to the Constitutional Convention and was one of the 39 people who signed the Constitution. While *Hamilton* is a musical rather than a history lesson, it brings the people and debates surrounding the founding of our country to life and gives us another way to appreciate the history we celebrate on Constitution Day.
